To welcome the refulgent season of Basant, our preschoolers adorned themselves as vibrant blossoms, creating an effervescent celebration of joy and enthusiasm.

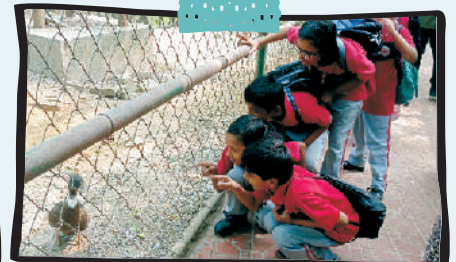
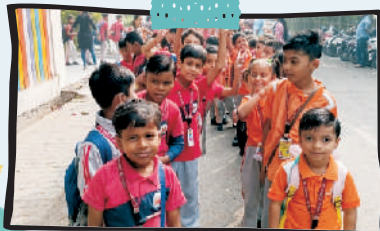

Moral: Books take us on magical journeys and help us learn in fun ways.

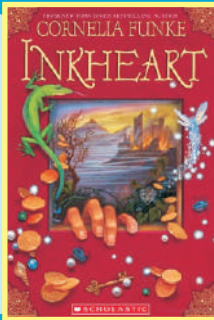

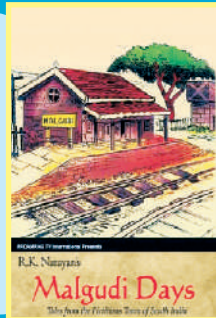
