SPICED BUTTERMILK : YUMMY SUMMER DRINK

Ingredients : 1 cup yogurt, 2 cups water, a handful of coriander leaves, a handful of curry leaves, a small piece of ginger, salt, to taste, a pinch of asafoetida, a few drops of oil, 1/4 tsp mustard seeds

INSTRUCTIONS :

1. Coarsely grind chili, ginger, coriander leaves, and curry leaves.
2. Whisk the yogurt and add 2 cups of water.
3. Mix in the coarsely ground mixture and salt.
4. Temper with mustard seeds and asafoetida.
5. Serve chilled.
