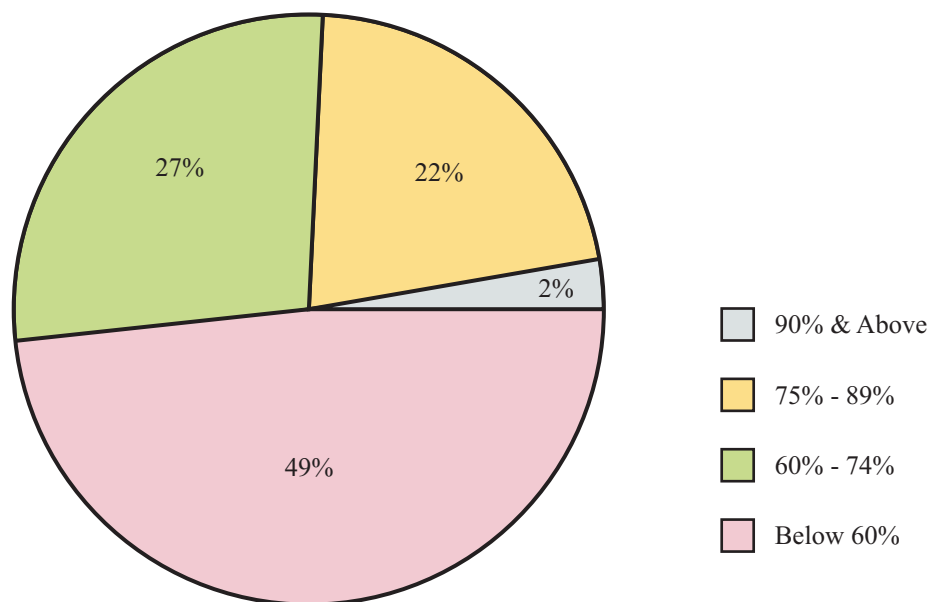

The academic analysis reveals that Grade 8 shows the most balanced and promising performance, while Grades 9 and 11 do not have students in the 90% and above category which is an area of concern. Most students fall within the 60%-74% range, highlighting the need for academic enrichment. To address this, the school is focusing on uplifting students in this bracket, refining pedagogy through teacher mentoring, and recognizing high achievers to boost motivation.

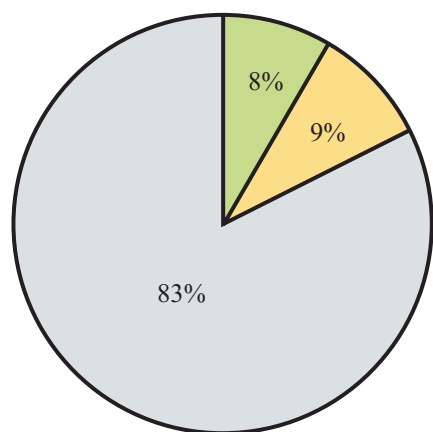
Academic Report

For the preschool section, results this year are strong, with most students achieving Grade A. K2 leads with the highest performance, while Nursery and K1 are also doing well. Only a few students are in Grade C, reflecting an overall solid academic foundation across the preschool.

In the grade school section, 551 students were assessed. Thirty-two students scored above 90%, while most fall within the 60% to 89% range. A total of 191 students scored below 60%, with Grades V showing the highest numbers in this category. Grade III recorded the highest achievers. Overall, performance levels vary across grades, highlighting both strengths and areas for further improvement.

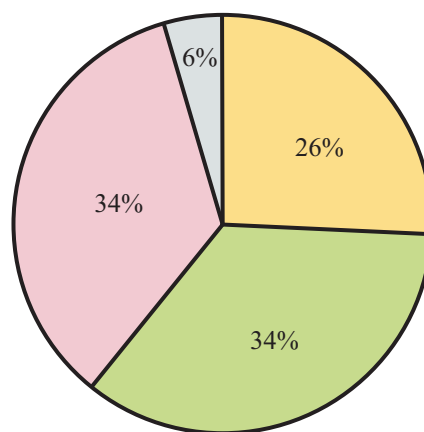

As we begin a new academic year, we are eager to witness the amazing achievements of our students.

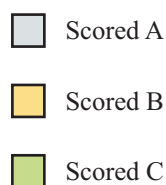
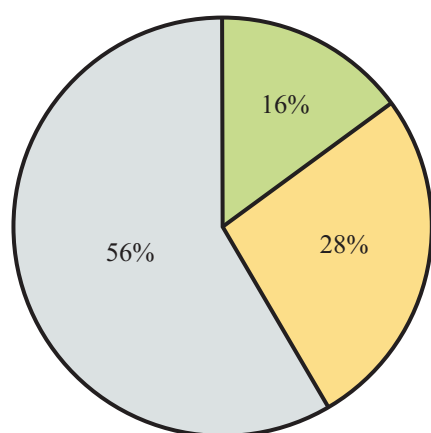

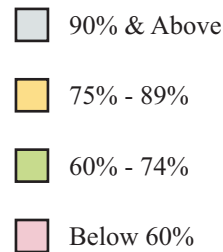
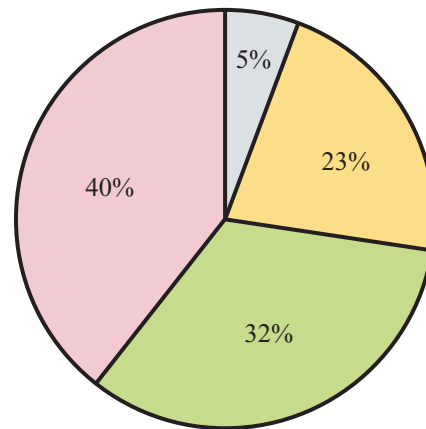
For the preschool section, results this year are strong, with most students achieving Grade A. K1 leads with the highest performance, while Nursery and K2 are also doing well. Only a few students are in Grade C, reflecting an overall solid academic foundation across the preschool. In the grade school section, 801 students were assessed. Thirty-six students scored above 90%, while most fall within the 60% to 89% range. A total of 324 students scored below 60%, with Grades V and VI showing the highest numbers in this category. 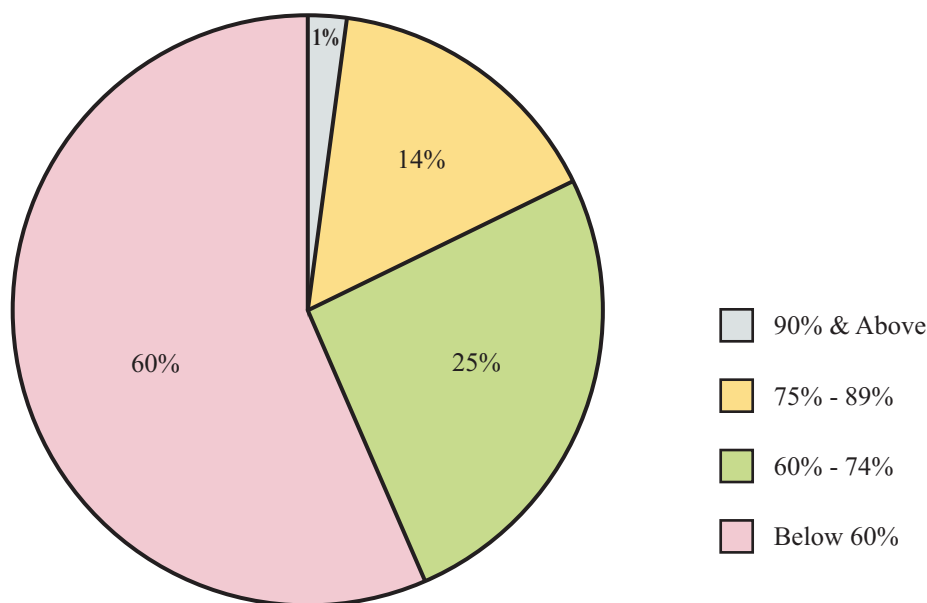

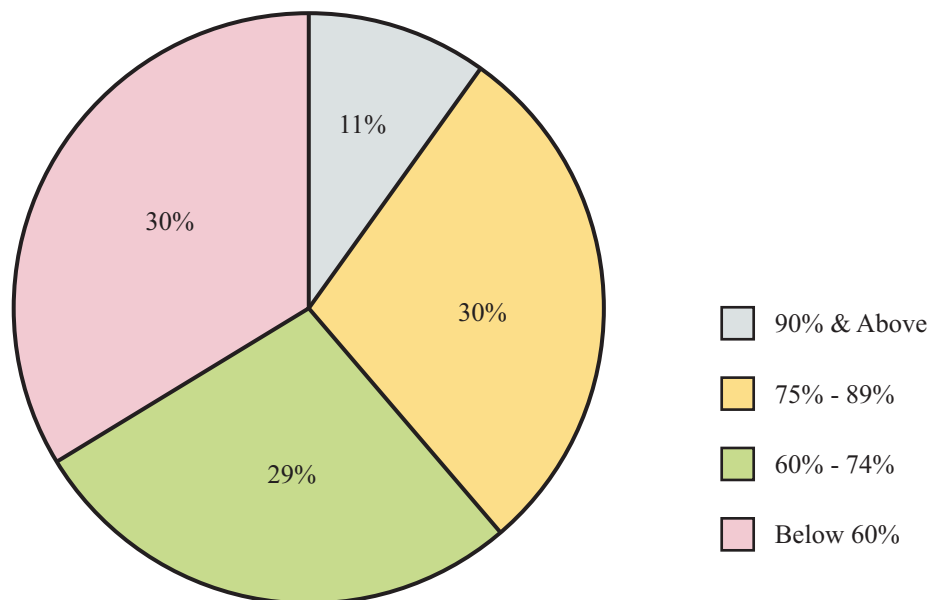

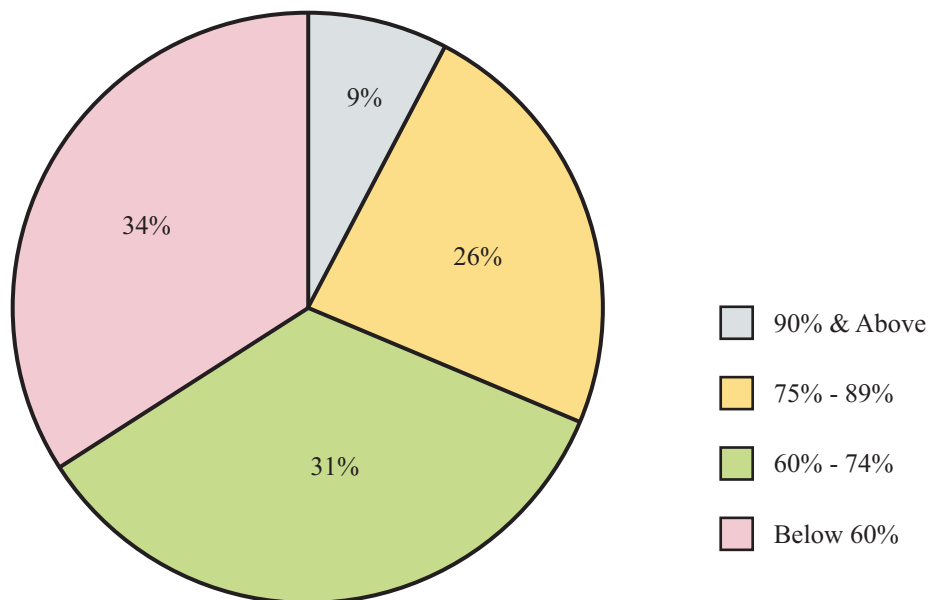

Government School's Report

PURNA DEVI KHANNA GIRLS INTER COLLEGE (GRADE 6 TO 12)

Purna Devi Khanna Girls Inter College was established in the year 1956. The school offers education from Class 6 to Class 12 for Science and Arts streams.

According to available records, during the 1991-92 academic session, the school had 3,500 students and 67 teachers. However, due to changing government policies, lack of facilities, dilapidated school buildings, and inadequate basic resources, the number of both students and teachers has been steadily declining over the years.

As a result, at present, the school has only 497 enrolled students, of whom 204 are in the Science stream and 210 are in the Arts stream. A total of 24 teachers are currently working in the institution.



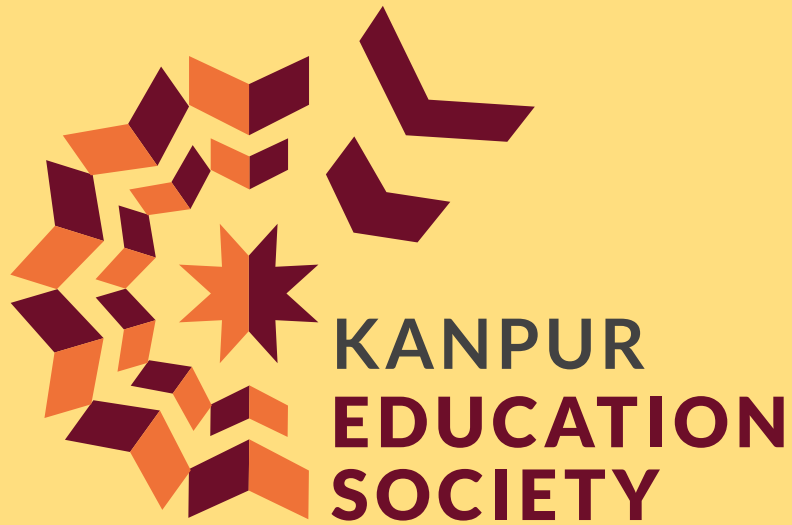
SHRI HIRALAL KHANNA VIDHYA MANDIR (GRADE 6 TO 12)



It is worth noting that Hira Lal Khanna Inter College, Jawahar Nagar, Kanpur was established in the year 1945. The school provides education to students from Class 6 to Class 12 (Boys Section). The academic streams offered at the school include Science, Arts, and Commerce.

According to available records, in 1989 the school had 1,539 students enrolled and 65 teachers working. However, due to government policies, lack of facilities, dilapidated school buildings, and insufficient basic resources, the number of both students and teachers has been steadily declining.

As a result, at present, the school has only 86 enrolled students, including 22 in the Science stream, 12 in the Arts stream, and 9 in the Commerce stream. The school currently has 13 teachers.
